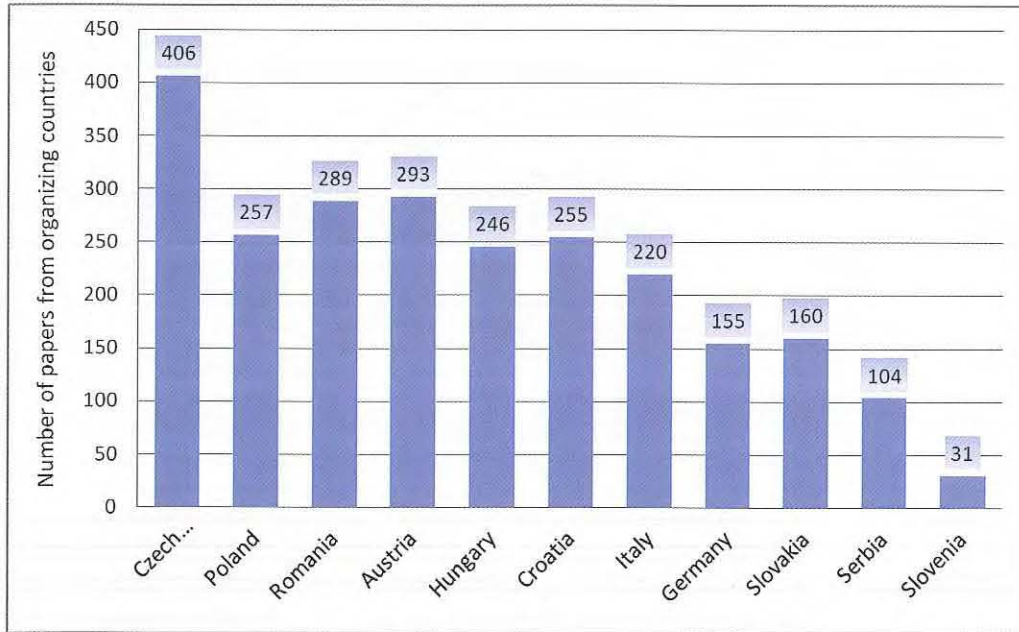

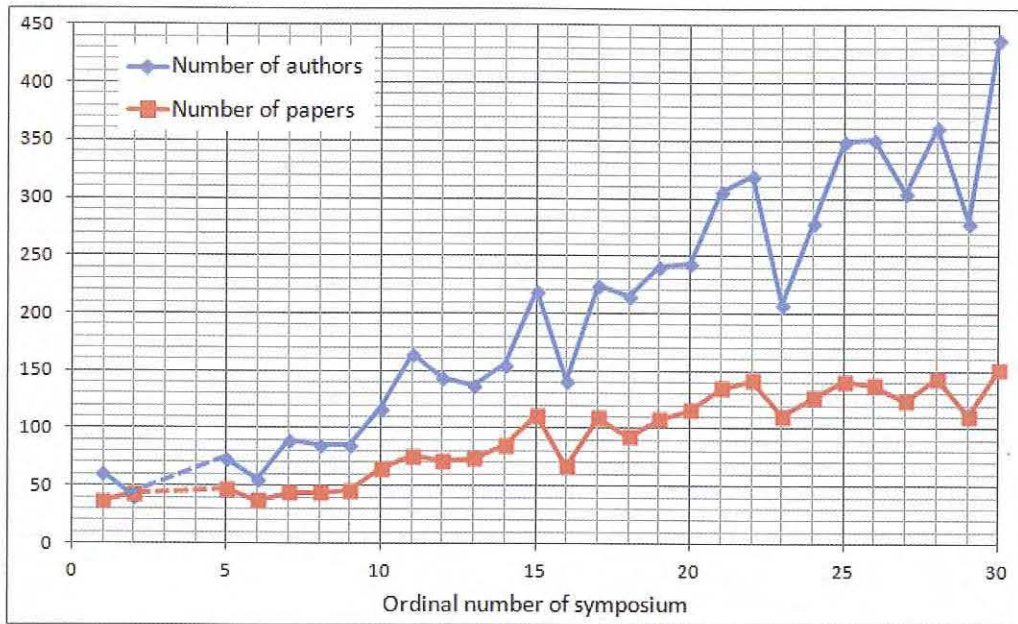

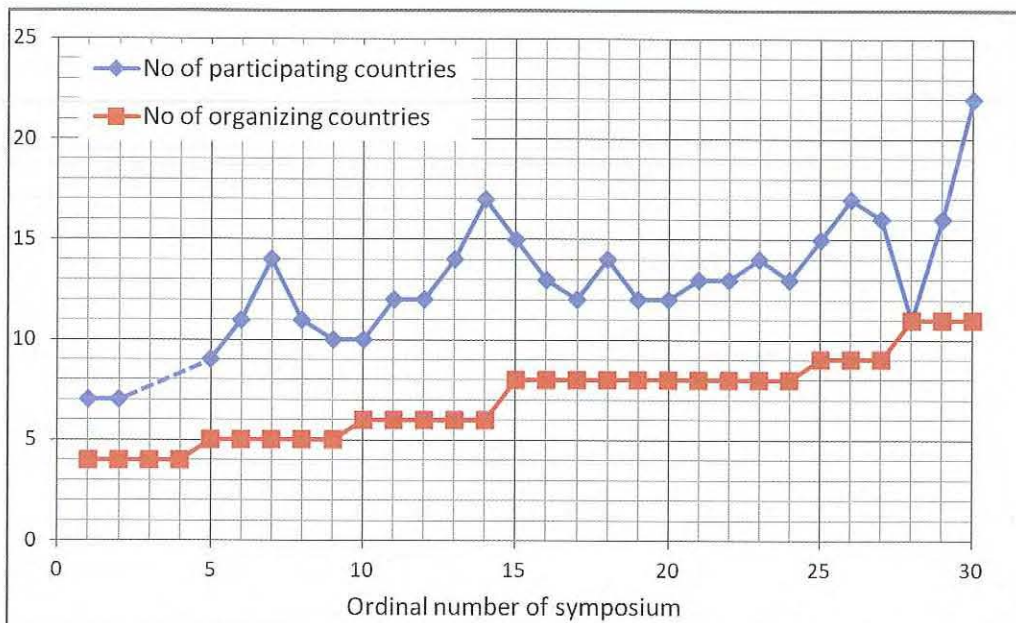
A total number of papers presented by authors from the organizing countries
